Could you please provide the **dates you are not available during 1 April to 30 Sept 2018.**

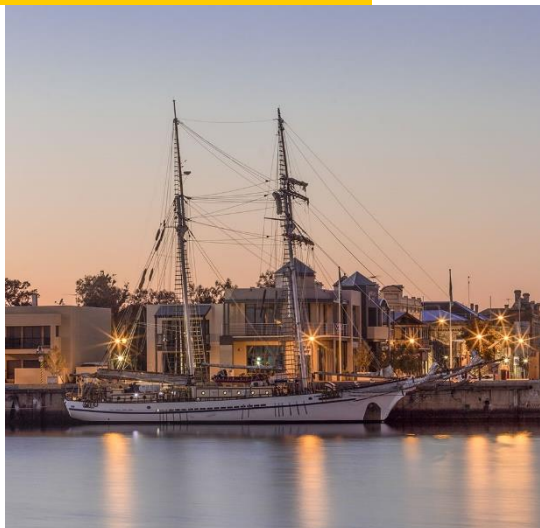

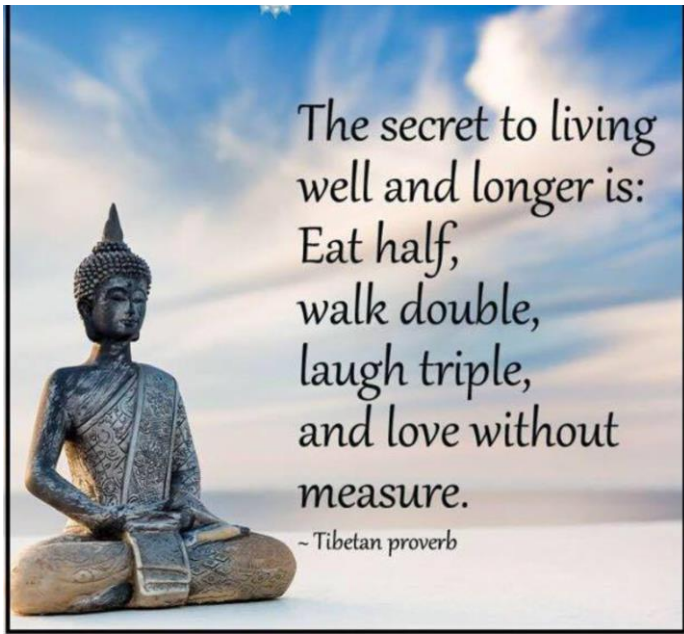

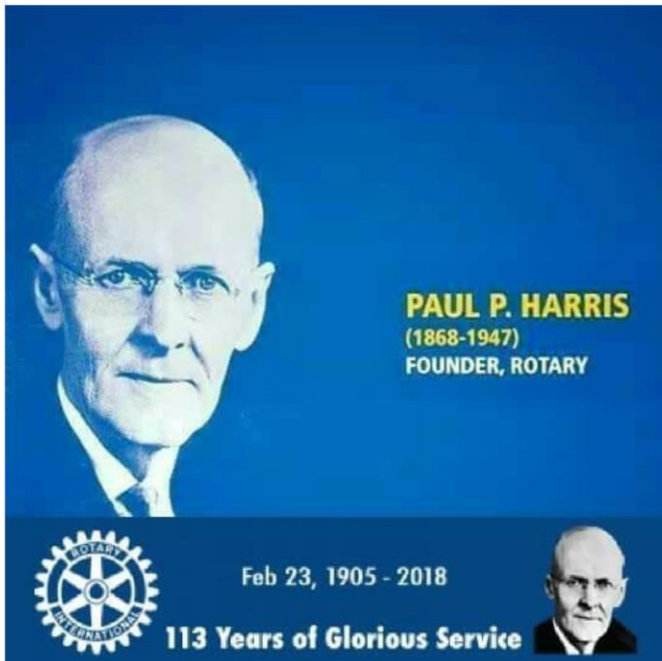
